MUSIC EXCELLENCE PROGRAMME

All Music Excellence Programme ensembles are open to all students at the school; however, students will need to be assessed by a member of the Music Department staff and will then be placed in the appropriate ensemble.

The school also offers all students the opportunity to have individual instrumental music lessons at school. The majority of lessons take place during the school day with students coming out of curriculum time on rotation to attend their lessons; pupils in the Pre Prep and also Senior School students from Year 9 upwards are given a fixed lesson time so that they can avoid missing other curriculum time. Instrumental lessons are 30 minutes in length and are taught by visiting teachers who are all practising professional musicians working with the Bangkok Symphony Orchestra, The Thailand Philharmonic Orchestra and other professional ensembles in Bangkok.
