Our primary bespoke campus is situated in the heart of the city with easy access to Rama 9 and the Sukhumvit area.

Set in a peaceful natural environment, City Campus is innovative in design and style.

Students benefit from learning spaces which are designed with flexibility in mind for different experiences and collaboration.

Our superb facilities sit on 25,000 square metres (15-rai land area) which include: an international-quality auditorium, a fully equipped air conditioned sports complex comprising of a gymnasium, ball courts, aquatic centre, running track and field;



a designated Early Years Centre, an extensive library, outstanding creative arts and music studios, safe and spacious outdoor playgrounds, a beautifully positioned dining hall and state of the art classrooms opening onto inspiring communal spaces.

Our family of schools are fully committed to an ongoing process of continual improvement and renewal, recognising the rapid changes required to keep pace with developments in technology and best practice in teaching and learning.



Music is the lifeblood of the Shrewsbury community. We nurture a delight in music-making, and the musical performances and events that are woven throughout the school calendar provide a chance for the whole community to celebrate in the joy of music and in the talents of our students.

Our curriculum ensures that all children have the opportunity to develop their musical interests. Choirs and musical ensembles provide a platform for children to develop their collaborative as well as performance skills, whilst a programme of individual tuition in a variety of instruments ensures that all children have the chance to take their talents further.

Our music facilities include extensive practice rooms and specialist rehearsal spaces that are centered around a beautifully appointed recital hall. It is in these spaces that the next generation of Shrewsbury musicians will develop the skills that may one day allow them to become part of Shrewsbury Riverside's renowned Symphony Orchestra or Senior Choirs or even, like many Shrewsbury musicians before them, to progress world-renowned conservatoires and careers in music beyond.

CREATIVE ARTS

Our creative curriculum brings excitement to learning, and colour to our campus.

Our classrooms are designed to stimulate the imagination, benefitting from wide views to the landscaped environment outside, whilst the spaces that connect them are a living canvas for the learning and work created within; exhibition spaces for displays, paintings, sculpture and pottery.

Our innovation hub is equipped with specialist studios and a dedicated centre for Design Technology - where Art meets science. A passion for creativity is a hallmark of a Shrewsbury education, underlined by numerous "Top in the World" awards for Shrewsbury students at IGCSE and A level, many of whom progress to the best art colleges in the world, studying Architecture, Fine Art, Fashion and Jewellery Design.





PERFORMING ARTS

Drama and performance form a major part of life at Shrewsbury International School. From the first days at school, children in our Early Years classes find their voice through singing, dancing and acting. As they get older, we provide regular opportunities to perform to a wider audience through class-led assemblies, performance poetry and whole year group productions in our world class auditorium.

Students build on the confidence and performance skills that are nurtured in their Primary years, taking part in theatrical activity ranging from improvised sketches to Shakespeare plays. Major plays and musicals are staged each year alongside productions

and performances devised and directed by students themselves.

For those wishing to pursue acting more seriously, IGCSE and A level Drama courses at Riverside provide an opportunity to broaden their experiences further, whilst Drama Scholarships are offered to students who demonstrate particular talent, passion and commitment todeveloping their stagecraft and technical production skills after school.





SPORTS

In common with Shrewsbury School in the UK and Bangkok campuses, we are serious about sport. We are firm in our belief that sport for all should be a part of school life and is crucial in the development of personal qualities. We provide an environment in which competitive talent and ambition is nurtured, alongside range of fun and wide-ranging sporting opportunities that ensure widespread participation and enjoyment in sport.

Our curriculum provides a framework for sporting participation for all children, and builds an understanding of the importance of physical activity as part of a healthy, balanced lifestyle. Meanwhile, our co-curricular activities programme provides gateway for involvement in a wide range of sports at a competitive level.

Our campus is equipped with superb sporting facilities including an indoor aquatics centre with 25m and learner pool, a dedicated gymnastics centre, an air conditioned sports hall with elevated running track, and a superb natural turf sports pitch and athletics spaces.

Guided by specialist teachers and coaches, boys and girls of every age and ability can discover and develop their personal passions in pursuits such as gymnastics, swimming and also in team games including such as basketball, football and volleyball.



Diversity prepares us for tomorrow's world - and the speaking of English brings us together. The ability to think, learn and communicate in English allows our students to achieve their full potential at school and opens the doors to life after Shrewsbury.

The Primary years lay the foundations for successful lifelong learning, and in children's ability to communicate and engage with the world around them. The "Harkness Method" - which develops skills in discourse, public speaking and debate - is introduced in the primary years, and is gradually built upon through a child's educational pathway at Shrewsbury. At its most mature stage the pre-university A-level programme at Riverside - this pathway is supplemented



with a bespoke "Reading the World" course, which English-language education for a dynamic completes the acquisition of university levels of English fluency.

We are committed to equipping children with the skills they need to become engaged and active participants in the global community, and will ensure that opportunities for language learning are effectively and efficiently embedded throughout their daily routine. As well as receiving the strongest possible foundation in the English Language, our school will also offer opportunities to develop core skills in Mandarin Chinese, and our curriculum will reflect our learning context in the Kingdom of Thailand, which will, for many of our future graduates, eventually become the content for their professional, working lives. A team of specialist multi-lingual staff support new children as they acquire the proficiency to access the curriculum, make friends and seize the opportunities offered by life at school.











Young people growing up in our fastpaced world face many challenges. We understand this and place the well-being of our students at the centre of all we do.

We recruit teachers who pride themselves on the care they give to every student and the partnerships they form with parents.
